

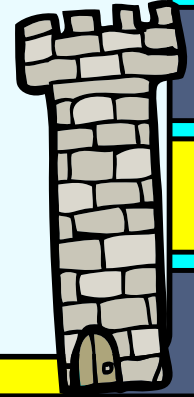

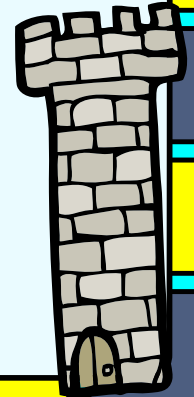
BUILD

There is a new girl in Bible class. When class is over, Cassie invites her to walk to the auditorium together and gets to know her.



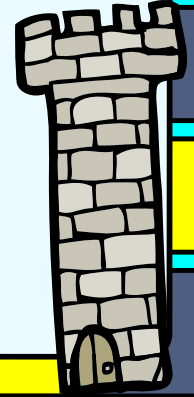
BUILD

Jacob is the youngest boy in the cabin at camp. He struggles to make his bed or open his suitcase. The older boys in the cabin notice and offer to help him.



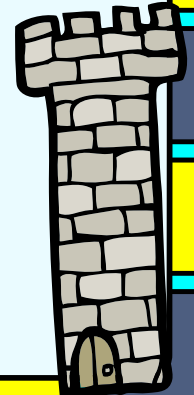

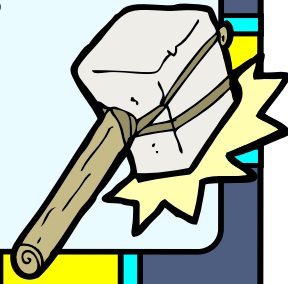

Mrs. Marla is an older widow that attends church. Most of her family lives far away. Laura and Holly always give her a hug and talk to her at church.



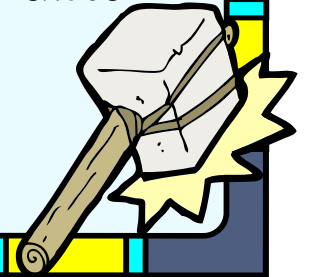

Carlos notices a new boy in Bible class. When class is over, Carlos and his friends push past the new boy as if he wasn't there to go and play.



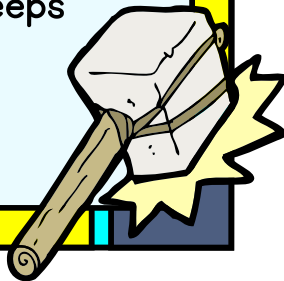
